

**Minutes of a Bramshill Parish Council Meeting
Held at Heckfield Village Hall
on Thursday 5th March 2026 at 7.00pm**

26/01 **Present:** SA, NS, BC, MS, AC, Cllr Tim Davies and three parishioners.

26/02 **Apologies:** Cllrs Anne Crampton, & Tim Southern

26/03 **Approved Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting** held on 20th November 2025 were signed by NS.

26/04 **Matters arising for AOB:** Cllr Davies (TD) spoke of time frame and restructure relating to the New Unitary Authorities within Hampshire. The Chairman mentioned traffic gridlock in Ford Lane caused by closure of M4 he also spoke of the demolition of Swallowfield Bridge by an HGV vehicle on the same day. The diverted route through Ford Lane is unsuitable for such vehicles.

26/05 **Finance:**

The income and expenditure statement and cash book figures had been circulated.

26/06 **Access/Highways:**

NS requested assistance from TD to urgently prioritise the dangerous pothole on the Bramshill Road.

MS to contact Ian James from HCC regarding broken signposts around the parish.

BC mentioned residue of mud following road cleaning by Collards caused by daily large movement of vehicles. TD to write to the director of Collards.

26/07 **Environment:**

GS had circulated details of recent planning applications from the last meeting, nothing major to report. BC to contact site administrators from Bramshill Park to request a site visit for the council.

26/08 **Crime: Neighbourhood Watch and Police Update.**

MS spoke of more fly tipping across the parish.

BC spoke of a police incident in January of a stolen car placed on a vacant property.

26/09 **AOB:**

The Chairman mentioned a recent report of a dog attack in Bramshill Plantation resulting in the death of one of the dogs. The owner of the surviving dog has agreed to muzzle the dog on all outings in future.

NS spoke of a possibility of the installation of a hedge row on the road edge of the Village

Green, costs, and funding to be researched.

Good News: finally parish minutes identified as missing in 2008, have been returned for safe keeping, they were found in a loft by the new owner of a property in North London.
