19/01 **Minutes of the last Annual Parish Assembly (APA) held on 8th May 2018**

19/02 Chairman's Report: The Chairman mentioned there had been very little to report for the past year other than the Bramshill House enquiry, which with the appeal being lost by City and Country, Hart District Council have been making progress with the follow up. The future of the site will remains unknown.

19/04 **Presentation by Graham Fortune from the Charles Kingsley Society**
Graham Fortune introduced himself as the Treasurer of the Charles Kingsley Society and David Lister, the Chairman. He went on to inform the parish of how Charles Kingsley had been the Rector of Eversley for 30 years, then becoming a University Professor, author of 19 books, a historian, campaigner for children's' rights, chaplain to Queen Victoria, private tutor to Prince of Wales, he died at the age of 56.

Mr Fortune informed us that the society would celebrate the 200 anniversary of the birth date of Charles Kingsley, he spoke of the Centenary Village Pageant that took place in June 1919 with a huge VIP attendance including Queen Alexandra, The Archbishop of Canterbury, the Duke of Wellington and many others, they hope to recreate this event this year. The all - day events will take place from 10.00am to 10.30 on 14-15th June at The Mount, Eversley with many activities and a performance of Andromeda a poem set to music and performed be Cantata Dramatica. Mr Fortune spoke of the cost of putting on the event which he described as a mini Haye Festival and of the £75000, 80% had been raised so far. The festival beneficiaries are Charles Kingsley School, and Eversley and Child of Hope Charity which is a Christian-based charity in Eastern Uganda.

The Chairman thanked Mr Fortune and Mr Lister for the presentation and making the Bramshill Residents aware of the festival.
