26/15 **Finance:**

GS advised the council that the year-end accounts for 2025-2026 had been prepared and that an internal audit had been carried out. The closing figure at the year-end was £2629.98. GS advised the council that this figure enabled BPC to proceed with exemption from an external audit. All councillors present unanimously agreed to this route. The Certificate of Exemption -AGAR form and the agreed accounts were signed by the Chairman following the meeting. All documentation will be posted onto the parish website and Notice Board. The publication requirements will also be posted onto the Parish Website and notice board on the 13th June and displayed for a 30 day period. The latest income and expenditure figures had been circulated; GS advised that £1750.00 precept had been received.

It was agreed that a donation would be made to St Mary's Eversley for the hire of the chapel.
