

**Bramshill Parish Council  
Minutes of the Meeting held at  
The Pheasantry, Bramshill Park  
on Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> December 2024 at 7.00pm**

24/29 **Present:** NS, SA, BC, MS, & Cllr Anne Crampton, and six parishioners.

24/30 **Apologies:** AC & Cllr Tim Southern

24/31 **Approved Minutes of the Annual General Meeting** held on 10<sup>th</sup> October 2024 were signed by NS

24/32 **Matters arising for AOB:** The blocked culverts on the parish land had been cleared, the residents of Copes Lane were grateful to BC and his team for carrying out the work.

24/33 **Finance:**

GS had circulated the budget and financial figures to all councillors, the precept figure was discussed, the Chairman mentioned that to keep the levels of the bank account even the figure of £1750.00 was proposed, all in agreement. Precept for 2025/2026 set at £1750.00.

GS spoke of the changes to the present bank account where charges would be introduced from January 2026. A new account with another provider suitable to our requirements was in the process of being set up.

The latest income and expenditure figures had been circulated.

**Invoice for BACS payment authorised:**

Glynis Spencer: - £375 for Parish Council duties July-Sept 2024

The balance of the bank account after the outstanding amount has been presented stands at £3332.08 including the grant balance of £400.

Finally GS mentioned that the insurance renewal due in February was predicted to remain the same as the current year.

24/34 **Access/Highways:**

SA mentioned that following the clearance of the blocked culverts in Copes Lane the water was now causing a problem on the Bramshill Road. The matter had been reported to Cllr T. Davies to contact Highways Dept.

24/35 **Environment:**

GS had circulated details of outstanding planning applications, no changes at all from the last meeting, delays with listed buildings applied to the historic applications.

24/36 **Crime: Neighbourhood Watch and Police Update.**

The Chairman mentioned that the new police station is now open and will be open on Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday weekly from 9am to 3pm. AC had attended the event and mentioned this was very positive.

MS spoke of the constant fly tipping episodes, no crimes reported within the parish.

24/37 **AOB:**

Cllr Crampton spoke of the new structure of the District and County Councils proposed by the government, together with the new housing targets.

Closing the meeting NS thanked Bob Coe for hosting the event.
